Before use check the condition and/or operation of the following:							
Boom: Any structural damage, wear, rust, loose parts.							
Main body: Check for any signs of damage..							
Configuration: Correctly configured for the job you will do.							
Inspect all fluide levels: Engine oil, hydraulic oil, brake, transmission...							
Inspect for fluid leaks: Hydraulic rams/hoses/lines.							
Signage is present and readable: rated capacity, data plate, decals...							
Tyres: Tyre pressure and condition.							
Load charts: Present and right ones for the reach stacker							
Stabilisers/outriggers (where fitted): Clean and secure.							
Safety tags: Check that there are no safety tags on the stacker.							
Logbook: Check there are daily checks and up to date. Repairs done.							
Nuts, bolts, pins, connection points: Damage, wear, loose parts.							
Cabin: Windows and mirrors, levers, gears for wear, damage, labels, extinguisher.
